## 

Music is broken into measures; each measure has an equal number of beats.
The most common time signature is $4 / 4$ time. In $4 / 4$ time each measure has four beats.
Measures are separated by bar lines. To end a song a double bar line is used.

Draw a rectangular pizza in-between each set of bar lines.

Divide your pizzas into $1,2,3$, or 4 pieces as a measure would be divided into four beats. Draw the correct music note in each divided section. Add any toppings you would like to your pizza :)

| Note | Note Name | Music Length | Pizza Size |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| $\delta$ | Quarter Note | 1 beat | $1 / 4$ or one fourth |
| $\delta$ | Half Note | 2 beats | $1 / 2$ or one half |
| $\delta$. | Dotted Half Note | 3 beats | $3 / 4$ or three quarters |
| $\mathbf{O}$ | Whole Note | 4 beats | 1 or one whole |
